Join us on Wednesdays at 1.00 pm for twenty minutes of readings, music and guided prayer, followed by refreshments.

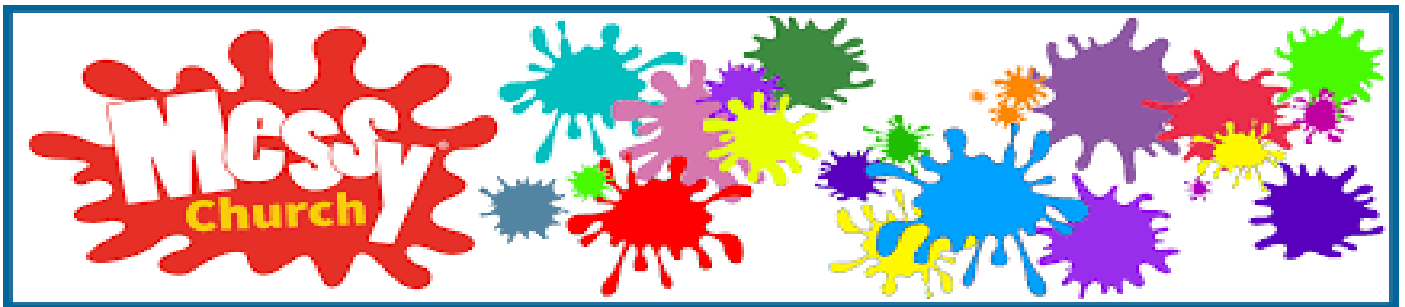
LENT REFLECTIONS
